# One Body Collaboratives



One Body Collaboratives is a faith based nonprofit with a mission to "Mobilize, Further Develop, and Coordinate Church and Community Resources To Rebuild Lives and Transform Our Community."

We achieve this through working with many partners in the community including: over 100 Local Churches, 40 Ministries and more than 120 Agencies; coordinating resources to help those in need.

2019 was a year of growth for One Body Collaboratives, from a new location for our Resource Coordination Center, to launching new tools and programs. In the pages that follow you will find an update on each of these and more.

### **Resource Coordination Center**

Coordinating Church and Community Resources

In 2019 we were blessed to have moved our Resource Coordination Center into the SwedishAmerican Riverfront YMCA, located at 200 Y Blvd in Rockford. The move allows us to expand our volunteer base which in turn means the capacity to serve even more individuals and families in need in our community! We are very grateful for the partnership we have built with the YMCA in our community and the potential to serve more residents.

Brent Pentenburg, CEO of the YMCA of Rock River Valley had this to say about our partnership: "I'm excited to see needs met, to see individuals feel like someone out there cares about and someone loves them and wants to help them out. Teaming up with organizations is critical for success. The partnership with One Body Collaboratives will allow us to serve our community together and meet the needs of our community."

Each year we receive over 1,500 calls to our Resource Coordination Center. The callers are referred by agencies, nonprofits, ministries and churches. In partnership with over 100 local churches, 40 ministry partners and over 100 local agencies, we are able to meet over 88% of the needs. The needs that we met and the resource provided impact over 500 local families in crisis annually.









# Gap Ministries Helping Us Fill the Gaps

In 2019, we partnered with 10 local churches to host Gap Ministries in our community. We continually assess where our Gap Ministries are located and where there are additional Gaps in community services. When we cannot locate resources to meet needs, we look to our partner churches to fill the gaps. When there is a high need for a specific resource, we can then ask our partner churches to consider creating a ministry to help fill that gap in the community. Here's how our Gap Ministries helped families in need:

- ▼ Baby Angel Closet at Willow Creek Presbyterian: 23 Families provided with diapers, baby wipes, baby wash and more
- Clothing Closet at Salem Lutheran: 86 Families provided a variety of clothing items
- ◆ Hope Closet at Hope Fellowship: 11 Families provided with dishes, silverware, and additional kitchen items
- Just in Time Food Pantry at First Evangelical Covenant: 19 Families provided with basic pantry items
- ◆ Linen's Closet at Redeemer Lutheran: 28 Families provided with linens, blanket, pillows and more
- ◆ Paper Angel Closet at Bethany Presbyterian, Brooke Road United Methodist, Church of the Holy Sprit, New Life United Methodist: 188 Families provided with paper products, household items and personal hygiene supplies
- ▼ Tools for Schools at Central Christian: 5 Families provided with backpacks, and a variety of school supplies
- Many of our Gap Ministries also contributed to a new partnership with Rockford Reach-out Jail Ministry, providing resources to individuals upon their release from incarceration

# Day of Compassion

## Presented by One Body Collaboratives

Many of our Partner Churches hosted collections during their respective church services during Day of Compassion weekend, September 28-29. The event is a demonstration of churches helping churches across denominational lines, all to benefit our community members in need.

The combined efforts of our Gap Ministries allow us to serve over 350 families in need each year, providing them with over \$30,000 worth of items collectively. Without these Gap Ministries many of our community members would simply go without these basic needs being met.

The items donated to our Gap Ministries throughout our Day of Compassion events helped fill their closets so that they may continue to be a blessing to those in need.



Bridges Out of Poverty is a national antipoverty organization that helps people move toward upward mobility. The focus of Bridges is on socioeconomic class differences, and helping people understand the importance of these factors and how they are related to their lives.




One Body Collaboratives is the managing organization for the community implementation, including creating a Community of Practice and implementing the Getting Ahead curriculum for individuals in poverty. One Body Collaboratives, through its Resource Coordination Center will provide ongoing support and resources for graduates of the Getting Ahead program.

On October 16th we held an Informational Community Meeting to launch our Bridges Out of Poverty initiative. Over 50 people attended representing over 15 local agencies and 10 area churches.

We have partnered with Transform Rockford on this initiative and have formed a Steering Committee to guide us in it's implementation. 


Needs By City




Needs By Zip Code



Needs By Age




Needs By Race




Top Reasons for Need: Unemployment, Low Income, Death in Family, Divorce, Relocated/Moved




